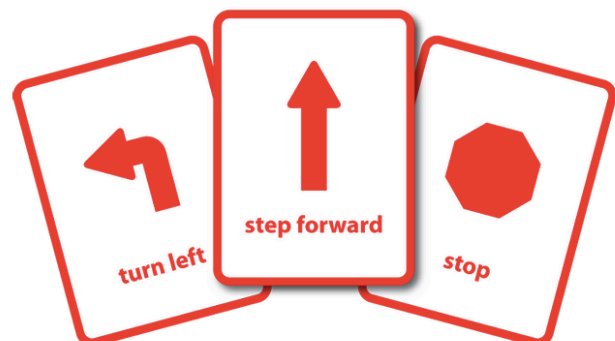
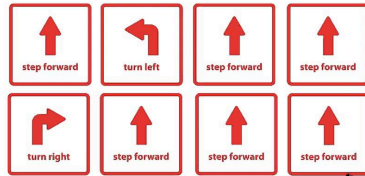
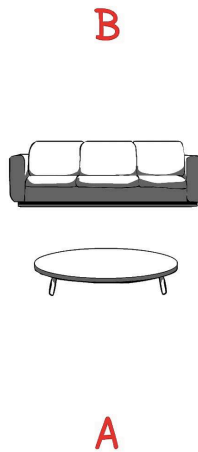


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Using the Action Cards, lay out a sequence of steps that will get your parent from point A to point B.
